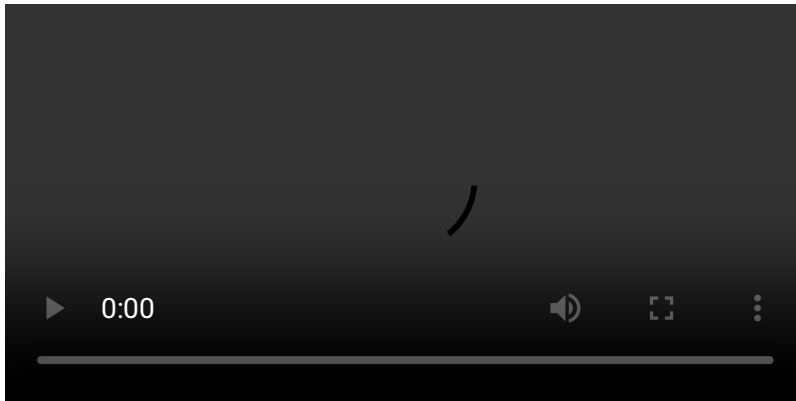
Images
